FOR NEW RESIDENTS

If you are a new resident to the Granite State or are planning to move to New Hampshire, the following is the procedure for registering your vehicle(s) and for obtaining a New Hampshire driver's license. State law requires that you obtain a registration and a driver's license within 60 days after taking residence here.

PLEASE BE AWARE that New Hampshire insurance policies are not compatible with the "No Fault System". ALSO, if you are not a "true" resident you may be in violation of the laws of your state and subject to severe penalty.

REGISTERING YOUR VEHICLE(S):

Registration may be a two-step process and will first require a trip to your local Town Clerk and may then require a visit to the nearest Motor Vehicle Station.

At the Town Clerk's office, you will apply for a registration "permit". The Clerk will ask for a description of your vehicle(s) (found on your present registration) and for the title to each vehicle. If the title is in the hands of a lending institution, the Town Clerk will advise you of the procedure to follow.

After receiving your registration permit, you will be issued license plates. (In some cases the Town Clerk may not have plates. If this is the case, you will take your registration permit to the nearest Motor Vehicle Sub-Station or to headquarters in Concord.)

The fee for the registration permit is based on the manufactured list price and age of the vehicle. The fee for the license plates is based on the weight of the vehicle.

OBTAINING A DRIVER'S LICENSE:

1. Valid Out-Of-State Driver License
2. Acceptable Proof of Residency
One of the following:
 - NH Valid Registration
 - Town/City Clerk Approval of Residency
 - Utility Bill With Postmark Date
 - NH Hunting or Fishing License
3. Acceptable Forms of Identification
NEED CERTIFIED BIRTH CERTIFICATE
Plus one of the following:
 - Passport, Marriage Certificate, Baptismal Certificate,
 - Social Security Card, Military ID
4. A Legal Document Reflecting a Name Change When Applicable
